

Oil and Gas Inspector

The PA Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has multiple openings for Oil and Gas Inspectors in the northwestern, southwestern and northcentral regions of PA. Duties include inspecting oil and gas drilling and underground storage operations within an assigned area of the state to determine and enforce compliance with state laws and regulations. The employee will inspect operating wells, underground gas storage reservoirs, Marcellus Shale reserves and abandoned wells; and inspect the methods used in plugging abandoned wells and reconditioning old wells. Additionally, the employee will provide assistance to representatives of the oil and gas industry on technical matters.

DEP is a state government agency responsible for administering PA's environmental laws and regulations related to air, water, waste, mineral resources, radiation, energy, and community revitalization. Many DEP positions are civil service; therefore, applicants must participate in civil service examinations to be considered for employment.

In order to qualify, applicants must possess five years of technical experience in the oil or natural gas extraction industry, at least one of which has been in the oil or natural gas extraction industry in the Commonwealth within the last three years, or any equivalent combination of experience and training. Annual salary ranges from \$41,017 to \$62,338. Benefits include comprehensive health insurance; liberal retirement/pension plan; paid vacation, personal and sick leave; paid holidays; prescription, vision and dental coverage; paid group life insurance; and more.
