Draft Proposed Rulemaking for Additional RACT Requirements for Major Sources of NO_x and VOCs (RACT III) – Sean Wenrich, Environmental Engineer Manager, Bureau of Air Quality, will discuss the draft proposed RACT III rulemaking. This proposed rulemaking amends Chapter 129 (relating to standards for sources) to adopt RACT requirements and RACT emission limitations for major stationary sources of oxides of nitrogen (NO_x) and volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions in existence on or before August 3, 2018. CO₂ Budget Trading Program – Hayley Book, Special Assistant to the Secretary, will provide an overview of the CO₂ Budget Trading Regulation that the Department is developing in order to participate in the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative.
