





ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY BOARD **PUBLIC HEARINGS** Proposed Amendments to Air Quality Regulations (25 Pa. Code Chapter 127) Air Quality Title V **Fee Amendment**

The Environmental Quality Board (Board) will hold three public hear-ings for the purpose of accepting comments on a proposed rulemaking to amend 25 Pa. Code Chapter 127, Subchapter I (relating to plan appro-val and operating permit fees)

The proposed rulemaking would amend § 127.705 (relating to emis-sion fees) to establish a base Title V annual emis-sion fee of \$85 per ton for up to 4,000 tons of for up to 4,000 tons of regulated pollutant, be-ginning with the fees due by September 1, 2014, for emissions from Title V facilities in the 2013 calendar year. The initial base Title V annu-al emission fee, establish-ed at 24 Pa.B. 5899, No-vember 26, 1994, was \$37 per ton of regulated pollutant up to 4,000 tons of each regulated poliutant op to 4,000 tons of each regulated poliutant per Title V fa-cility. As provided in § 127.705(e), the emission fee imposed under § 127.705(a) has been increased in each year af-ter November 26, 1994, by the percentage, if any, by which the Con-sumer Price Index for the most recent calendar year exceeds the Con-sumer Price Index for the previous calendar year. Under the existing regu-latory framework, the base Title V annual emission fee has not been re-vised since 1994. The Ti-tle V annual emission fee due September 1. 2012, for emissions occur-ring in calendar year 2011 was \$56 per ton of regulated pollutant for up to 4,000 tons of each regulated pollutant.

Minor clarifying amend-ments are proposed for § 127.701 (relating to general provisions). The proposed rulemaking would revise § 127.701 to clarify that fees paid to the Department are deposited into the Penn-sylvania Clean Air Fund sylvania Clean Air Fund. The proposal would also make additional editorial changes to this section.

This proposed rulemaking will be effective upon final-form publica-tion in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.

The proposed rulemaking will be submit-ted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency upon final-form publication for approval as a revision to the Commonwealth's State Implementation Plan or as an amendment to the Title V Pro gram Approval codified in 40 CFR Part 70, Appendix A (relating to appro-val status of state and local operating permits programs), as appropriate
