
Dear Governor Rendell;

HydroGen LLC is a fuel cell manufacturer based in Versailles, Pennsylvania. We are in the process of commercializing a 2 megawatt fuel cell based on Phosphoric Acid Fuel Cell technology originally developed by Westinghouse Corporation. Over the past three years, our company has grown from seven employees to over seventy-five. We are currently the largest employer in Versailles, and have created a world-class manufacturing facility. Our network of collaborators and suppliers is extensive in the Pittsburgh area as well as throughout the Commonwealth, and we have a deep and productive relationship with the University of Pittsburgh. Our market approach is to deploy these fuel cells into industries with waste hydrogen produced in the course of other manufacturing operations. There is significant market potential within Pennsylvania and even more significant potential for us to export this product within the United States and globally. Our efforts to fund our operations have been done mainly through the private sector with little government support.

We are very excited about your proposed Energy Independence Strategy as it encompasses both the deployment of alternative energy sources within Pennsylvania and accelerates the growth of clean energy manufacturing in Pennsylvania. We view both of these elements as critical components in the growth of our company as well as other companies focused on alternative energy development.

HydroGen fully supports all efforts to advance clean energy production and we would be pleased to provide any support necessary to secure the approval of this program. I believe that HydroGen has a tremendous future in this area and will grow to be an even bigger asset in the effort to develop clean alternative sources of energy. Additionally, I would like to extend an invitation for you, your staff, and any legislators involved in the roll-out of the Energy Independence Strategy to visit our facilities in Versailles to see our operations and see firsthand the growth of an exciting industry.
