The Department has investigated the degradation of your water supply in response to your September 16, 2008, complaint that recent drilling activities conducted by Cabot Oil and Gas, Inc. has affected your water supply.

On September 18, 2008, I collected a water sample from your well at your residence. The analytical results for that sample are enclosed, along with additional information to assist you with interpreting the results. After reviewing the sample results and other information gathered during our investigation, the Department has determined that your water supply has been affected by drilling activities conducted by Cabot Oil and Gas, Inc.

The Department is aware that Cabot Oil and Gas, Inc. has installed treatment equipment in order to restore your water supply to pre-drill conditions. As you are aware, I am currently awaiting results for the most recent pre-treatment and post-treatment samples that I collected on 11/19/2008 and I will keep you apprised of any new information.
