In response to your complaint of June 8, 2012, the Department has investigated the possible diminution of your water supply by gas well activities at the Interstate Gas Marketing, Inc. [REDACTED] well, [REDACTED]

On June 12, 2012, July 10, 2012 and September 4, 2012, Water Quality Specialist Ruth A. Taylor sampled your water supply, which was analyzed by our laboratory in Harrisburg. Enclosed is a copy of the analysis reports for your samples. Also enclosed is a fact sheet explaining maximum contaminant levels and interpretations of sample results.

As a result of our investigation and review of the sample analyses, the Department has determined that the drilling, alteration or operation of the aforementioned gas well temporarily affected the quality your water supply, which has subsequently returned to pre-drill quality. No evidence of diminution was documented by the Department during our investigation.
