My name is Sally Wilson I live at ~~141 Lakewood~~ Pequea, Pennsylvania.
~~This~~ development is known as Lakewood Estates and is comprised of about 150 homes we are bordered by the part of Conservancy known as Trout Run. We love our life here.

I requested to speak this evening regarding the water as it affects our neighborhood. There are wetlands along Pennsy Road as well as a few ponds that come and go depending on drought. When we moved down to the development 14 years ago there were a few vacant Lots because they would not perk. Over the years have watched countless neighbors have to redrill or drill deeper in order to have water. My lot personally contains two Wells. Maintaining Wells and septic systems are not insignificant costs born by home owners.

As a result of the pipeline being built I have to have a septic inspection and my water tested as a protective measure. My understanding is the nature of the comprehensive water testing to make sure of a pre pipeline construction quality is not inexpensive.

Further, My understanding is they are taking somewhere in the neighborhood of ~~1 million~~ ^{thousands} gallons of water from the Conestoga Creek and ~~1 million~~ ^{thousands} gallons of water from the Pequea so I am concerned about not having enough drinking water and I am concerned about the safety of the water that I drink should construction chemicals leach into the groundwater. I am also concerned about where water would come from should there be a large explosion if all of this water is taken from the Conestoga and the Pequea.

Our neighborhood is landlocked. I drew a crude map going by their stakes in the roads to show that if this pipeline is constructed in the path that they have staked it and it leaks or blows up we would have no way out of our neighborhood.

The pipeline crosses 324 north of my development. It then crosses Pennsy Road. It crosses Lakewood near the entrance to Red Hill Road and outside of Oak Glen it crosses Red Hill Road again then then it crosses at Stump Road which leads to 222 and then martic Heights Road. You can't turn right if you got there because the pipeline weaves back again.

You cannot go south west of if you got out of Lakewood and up River Road to get out because pipeline crosses that too. This leaves approximately 150 homes with No way out in the event of an emergency.

We cannot drive through trees through Rock outcropping through explosions and over creeks. This is not an action movie. This Is My Life.

My question is what makes my life so expendable that there is no consideration in the event of an emergency?
