- This project is no exception and involvement, which has been ongoing for more than 2 years, has allowed the pipeline project area to greatly evolve in a collaborative effort to reduce environmental, archaeological and cultural impacts w/in and along its corridor
- Efforts which will reduce impact during construction and once construction has been completed
- Reclamation efforts are proposed that will repair woodlands along streams in temporary construction areas, create wetlands offsite (similar to what PennDOT would do), and perform streambank restoration where necessary
- X The overall process allows for transparency between owner, agency and the public
- Review comments show that these applications are considered carefully and w/ the benefit of all stakeholders involved which includes public interests
