This letter is in reference to the request submitted by your consultant and received by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) on March 25, 2019, including additional information received through June 22, 2020, for a major permit amendment for Chapter 105 Permit No. E23-524.

The horizontal directional drill (HDD) S3-0620 site modifications are for a change in the HDD installation method for the 20-inch and portions of the 16-inch diameter pipelines to a conventional open trench construction through Wetland WL-I1 and Stream S-I2, conventional auger bore under Glen Riddle Road, and a direct pipe under Riddlewood Drive and the Southeast Pennsylvania Transportation Authority's (SEPTA) Railroad in Middletown Township, Delaware County.

Please be advised that DEP has reviewed and approved your request and the Chapter 105 Permit No. E23-524 is amended to include the revised activities.

All conditions specified in the original permit remain in effect and are to be complied with as part of this plan revision. Please ensure that the plans are fully implemented and available at the construction site.
