The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the supplemental HDD analysis submitted for Frankstown Branch Juniata River Horizontal Directional Drill Location (S2-0140), and the public comments that DEP received on December 18, 2017. The supplemental information is adequate. You may proceed with the permitted HDD activity in the manner proposed in your re-evaluation and in accordance with all applicable permit terms and conditions upon the lifting of the suspension imposed by the Department's Order dated January 3, 2018. No HDD activity may occur at this site until the suspension is lifted in writing by the Department.

The use of flocculants or any other chemical treatment additives to the potential groundwater or surface water discharge may require a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit. Prior to drilling, contact Ms. Brenda Fruchtl in DEP's Clean Water Program at 717-705-4812 or email at bfruchtl@pa.gov for information on obtaining an NPDES permit.

The addition of temporary work space may require E&S plan change approvals. Prior to drilling, contact the Blair County Conservation District for an E&S plan change determination and modification.
