 adequacy of fees and report to Environmental
 Quality Board (EQB)

Table 1. Fee for Chapter 102 Permits Under 25 Pa. Code § 102.6(b)(1)

Fee Type	Permit Type	Fee
Base Administrative Filing Fee	General Permits (NPDES PAG-02 and ESCGP)	\$500
Base Administrative Filing Fee	Individual Permits (NPDES and E&S)	\$1,500
Disturbed Acreage Fee	All Permits	\$100 x each disturbed acre

- Fees:
 - Fees collected by DEP
 - Additional Administrative Filing Fee (i.e., Disturbed Acreage Fee)
 - Base Administrative Filing Fee
 - Fees collected by County Conservation Districts
 - Base Administrative Filing Fee
 - Service Fee (E&S and PCSM, if applicable)

- Program Costs = DEP Staff Costs (Central and Regional Offices)
- Fees Collected = Base Administrative Filing
 Fees & Disturbed Acreage Fees

Projections

- Fiscal Years (FY); 2018 2019, 2019 2020,
 and 2020 2021
- Program Costs estimated to increase by 4%
- Fee Collected estimated to increase by 4.4%
 for FY 2018 2019 and then by 2.4% after that

	FY 2019-20	FY 2020-21	FY 2021-22
Projected Program Cost	\$13,721,315	\$14,270,167	\$14,840,974
Projected Fees Collected	\$12,528,667	\$12,829,355	\$13,137,260
Projected Difference (\$)	-\$1,192,648	-\$1,440,812	-\$1,703,715
Ratio	91%	90%	89%



Recommendation

- Fees collected are projected to cover only about 75% of DEP's and about 90% of Districts' expenses to implement the Chapter 102 program over the next three years.
- DEP is recommending an increase in Chapter 102 fees and plans to begin drafting a proposed rulemaking to address the discrepancy in the costs and revenue to operate the Program.
