

Chapter 105 Dam Safety and Waterway Management

Overview of Proposed Regulation Revisions Water Resources Advisory Committee Meeting January 30, 2020

Purpose

Department is proposing amendments to:

- Clarify existing requirements
- Delete or update obsolete requirements and references
- Incorporate new or revised sections and definitions to codify existing practices
- Correct typographical errors

- Adds, revises, deletes definitions in Section 105.1
 - Abandonment
 - Aquatic resource functions
 - Aquatic resource restoration
 - Conservation district
 - Crop production
 - Cross-Section
 - Maintenance
 - Probable Maximum Flood (PMF)

- Section 105.1 Definitions (Cont.)
 - Probable Maximum Precipitation (PMP)
 - Project
 - Project purpose
 - Reservoir
 - Stormwater management facilities
 - Water dependent
 - Wetland functions

- Section 105.2 Purposes
 - Revises language by adding "restore and improve" to conserve and protect.
 - Adds aquatic resource functions and geomorphic stability to water quality, natural regime and carrying capacity.
 - Adds language referencing "regulated waters of this Commonwealth"
- Section 105.3 Scope
 - Adds language to update and allow for future updates to NOAA's National Geodetic Survey (NGS) International Great Lakes Datum elevation criteria.

- Section 105.12 Waiver of permit requirements
 - Clarifies subsections (a)(1), (2), (3), (11), (16) and (b)(1).
 - Adds new waivers :
 - Streambank fencing conservation practice associated with crop production (i.e. grazing)
 - Passive, low impact, and non-motorized recreational activities
 - Elevated boardwalks in wetlands for educational and interpretive trails
 - Emergency water withdrawal for agricultural and fire protection
 - Temporary environmental testing, monitoring or investigative activities
 - Temporary mats and pads in wetlands

- Section 105.13 Regulated activities—information and fees
 - Adds additional payment methods
 - Corrects fees related to Dam Permit Transfers
 - Provides an option for submission of disturbance fee
 - Adds reference of "multiple" counties in subsection (d)
 - Revises subsection (e) and (e)(1) for clarity and organization of application information

- Section 105.13, Subsection (e)(1) requirements
 - Clarifies demarcation of floodplains, floodways and regulated waters
 - Clarifies scale and cross-section standards
 - Adds details on water dependency for clarification
 - Updates stormwater and floodplain management
 - Adds alternatives analysis description
 - Updates mitigation plan terms
 - Adds antidegradation demonstration
 - Clarifies impacts and cumulative impacts analysis
 - Revises information regarding incomplete applications

- Section 105.13 continued
 - Updates references to Chapter 102
 - Clarifies requirements for partnerships and political subdivisions
 - Provides a reference for electronic permit application submissions
 - Adds new requirement related to geologic information
 - Revises subsection (k) to identify the Department's discretion on waiving application information
 - Clarifies the reference of the EQB.

- Section 105.13a. Complete applications
 - Adds clarifying language
 - Adds references to conservation district
 - Adds new language requiring the confirmation of extensions in writing
- Section 105.13b. Proof of financial responsibility
 - Adds enrollment to the Private Dam Financial Assurance Program as an option.

- Section 105.14. Review of applications.
 - Adds references for consistency and clarity
 - New subsection clarifying review requirements for proposed impacts to wetlands
- Section 105.15. Environmental assessment.
 - Corrects reference and cross references
 - New criteria for aquatic resource restoration activities
- Section 105.16. Environmental, social and economic balancing

- Section 105.20a. Compensation for impacts to regulated waters of this Commonwealth
 - Revisions to address compensation of impacted aquatic resources and no net loss of wetlands
 - Revisions to siting criteria for consistency with mitigation banking, in lieu fee, and permittee responsible compensation
 - Establishes compensation factors
 - Deletes antiquated guidance and provided reference to technical guidance documents/methodologies

- Section 105.21. Criteria for permit issuance and denial
- Section 105.25. Transfer of permits.
 - Adds clarifying language
 - Adds new subsection (f) relating to include transfer of ownership of dams not needing permits.

- Section 105.35 Charges for use and occupation of submerged lands of this Commonwealth
 - Clarifies mooring areas are associated with barge fleeting only.
 - Clarifies general permits are for recreational docks/ramps.
 - Adds clarifying language in (c)(6) and (7).
 - Adds new exemptions (c)(8) and (c)(9):
 - Environmental remediation, reclamation, restoration and protection activities
 - Temporary activities

- Section 105.43. Time limits.
 - Revises Subsection (c) relating to dams
- Section 105.47. Removal of dams and removal or abandonment of water obstructions and encroachments.
 - Clarifies removal of public health, safety and environment concerns
- Section 105.53. Inspections by permittees or owners and inspection reports.
 - Clarifies inspection requirement for conduits

- Sections 105.81 105.82 and 105.89
 - Corrects citations
 - Revises 105.82(a)(9) to clarify need for easements
- Section 105.96. Outlet Works
 - Revises section to clarify drawdown requirements
 - Adds ability to waive or modify drawdown requirements
- Section 105.97. Stability of structures:
 - Revises the terminology used in this Section for consistency with the U.S. Corps of Engineer's standard design terminology.
- Section 105.98. Design flood criteria:
 - Revises section to clarify the design flood criteria.

- Sections 105.121, 105.122, 105.123, 105.171
 - Removes or updates antiquated references.
- Section 105.134. EAP
 - Updates information to be submitted
- Section 105.161. Hydraulic capacity
 - Updates references

- Section 105.401. Permit applications
 - Revises and updates
- Section 105.411. General criteria
 - Revises reference
- Section 105.446. Procedure for issuance
 - Adds new section on periodic reviews
- Section 105.451. Identification and delineation of wetlands – statement of policy
 - Updates references
- Section 105.452. Status of prior converted cropland—statement of policy
 - Updates and clarifies policy
