Small Businesses in PA

DEP Definition - Fewer than 100 FTE employees

US Small Business Administration: 500 employees

- 1M Small Businesses in Pennsylvania
- Small Businesses Employed 2.5M
- 46.7% of the private sector labor force
- 99.6% of the state's employers are Small Businesses

Small Business Assistance Program

 Required by the 1990 Federal Clean Air Act and the PA Air Pollution Control Act.

 Created in recognition of the difficulties faced by small business in complying with environmental regulations.



Small Business Assistance Program

3 Required Components of the Federal Clean Air Act of 1990

- Small Business Ombudsman
- Small Business Compliance Advisory Committee
- Small Business Compliance Assistance Program



Small Business Ombudsman

 Primary advocate for small businesses within DEP, regardless of program.

 Ombudsman's role is to work with the small business in disputes with the Department.



Small Business Ombudsman

- Provides information and assistance for other Commonwealth programs
 - ✓ DCED
 - ✓ Agriculture
 - ✓ L&I, etc.
- All contacts, by law, are kept confidential



Small Business Ombudsman

- Reviews proposed regulations
- Investigates small business complaints
- Provide information on energy efficiency and pollution prevention opportunities:
 - Small Business Advantage Grant
 - Pollution Prevention Assistance Account



Small Business Compliance Advisory Committee

- Advises DEP on issues affecting small business
- Reviews proposed & existing regulations and provides comments to the Department on the effect to the small business community
- Meets quarterly



The Environmental Management Assistance
Program or **EMAP** provides free
environmental compliance and technical
assistance services to small businesses in PA

* Not to be confused with eMapPA



- Designed to address small business concerns such as:
 - ✓ What regulations affect me?
 - ✓ What do I need to do to comply?
 - ✓ How do I keep compliance costs down?
 - ✓ Where can I get information/help?



EMAP is a Partnership with the PA Small Business Development Centers SBDC

Partnership with SBDC provides "one-stop shopping" for small businesses

18 SBDC offices located throughout the Commonwealth at local colleges and universities

- For startups and existing businesses
- For businesses relocating to PA
