


Stream Redesignation Petition


- Submit petition to EQB via Policy Office
- Completeness review
- Present to EQB for consideration
- If accepted by EQB for further study,
 - Department conducts biological survey; file search; and public information request



Current Designation: CWF



Proposed Designation: EV



Water quality and biological data was provided in support of the petitions for Beaverdam, Killbuck and Wyerough Runs.

The petitioner believes an assessment of the submitted information will qualify the petitioned streams for Exceptional Value redesignation.



Department Findings

- Petitions are complete
 - Information requirements have been met as defined in §23.2 of the EQB Petition Policy
- Redesignation requests do not conflict with federal law



Recommendation

- The Department recommends the acceptance of all three petitions for further study.
- If accepted, because of their close proximity and common base of supportive information, these three petitions will be studied and managed concurrently as if they are one petition.
