



Petition to Redesignate a Portion of the South Fork of Tenmile Creek Watershed







Proposed New Mine

- Foundation entities currently operate two underground coal mines in Greene County and employ more than 1100 people
- Total employment for the new complex is projected to be 1041 people
- Estimated lifespan is 30 years
- Representative project economics:
 - ✓ Initial construction capital in excess of \$400 million
 - ✓ Sustaining capital of 30 year lifespan in excess of \$1.5 billion
 - ✓ Annual wages, benefits, taxes and other impacts similar to existing Emerald and Cumberland mines

Conclusions

- 1. Foundation is pursuing the Petition to redesignate 10.6 stream miles of the South Fork of Tenmile Creek watershed in conjunction with the permitting of a proposed new underground coal mine
- 2. The reason for the original "HQ" designation no longer exists the Waynesburg surface water intake has been removed
- 3. The existing database indicates that the streams do not meet the "HQ" criteria at 25 Pa. Code § 93.4b, and the Petition will allow further study
