Narrative: I arrived at the Energy Transfer (ET) trailer at 9:26 to speak with Nancy Sadlon and see what activities are planned. She stated the following: 1. The ERI testing will be performed the next day on line #2. 2. Passive soil gas sampling is continuing., 3. The second round of residential potable well water sampling is continuing, 4. The community meeting that was scheduled on Thursday 3-13-25 has been moved to Tuesday 3-11-25. 5. The Township has retained David Fenimore, P.G. of Earth Data as a consultant. 6. The well drilling on 108 Spencer Road was postponed until the settlement was finalized, which was to happen on Friday 7, 2025 7. Drilling is expected to start by the end of the month. 8. ET is waiting on a road permit to be approved by the township. I left the ET trailer at 10:00 and drove to the residential neighborhood to see if there were any activities being performed that day. I encountered William Holder (GES) in front of 115 Walker Road. He informed me that the residential wells that were scheduled to be sampled that day, they opened the well head to get a PID reading. A disposable bailer was then dropped into the well to verify if there was LNAPL present. He told me that they had been to 110 Glenwood Drive and 125 Walker Road, there were no PID readings or LNAPL present in either of the two wells. 
