## NOTICE OF INTENT TO REMEDIATE

Pursuant to the Land Recycling and Environmental Remediation Standards Act, the act of May 19, 1995, P.L. 4, No. 1995-2, notice is hereby given that Sunoco Pipeline, LP (SPLP) has submitted to Pennsylvania Departthe ment of Environmental Protection a Notice of Intent to Remediate (NIR) a site located near the intersection of Glenwood Drive and Walker Road in Upper Makefield Township in Bucks County, PA. This NIR states that a release from an underground 14-inch diameter pipeline resulted in certain soil and groundwater media being impacted with jet fuel and/or gasoline constituents. SPLP has indicated that remediation measures will include soil excavation and product recovery. The proposed future use of the affected portion of the property will be residential.


