AECOM requests the PA SHPO's comments on potential effects to historic properties for Shell Pipeline Company, LP (Shell) Falcon Ethane Pipeline Project (Project) in Washington, Allegheny, and Beaver Counties, Pennsylvania (PA).

Enclosed please find an addendum to the initial Historic Architectural Reconnaissance Report submitted to your office in November 2016. Since the submittal of the initial report the Project has undergone reroutes and alignment shifts. This addendum presents the results of additional reconnaissance survey and assessments of effects conducted for historic architectural resources within the updated project area. The survey identified an additional 26 historic architectural resources, six of which were previously recorded. Preliminary NRHP evaluations and assessment of effects and abbreviated HRSF for resources with the potential to be impacted are provided in the report.
