

The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) is submitting for approval a State Implementation Plan (SIP) revision in order to meet the requirements of Reasonably Available Control Technology (RACT) set forth by the Clean Air Act (CAA) for Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania.
