

Community Benefits Bonus: Updated Mapping Tool Instructions

The RISE PA Community Benefits Bonus (CBB) application requires applicants to identify whether their facility is located in an Impacted Community. For the RISE PA program this status will be determined using the PennEnviroScreen Mapping Tool and will include any location with a PennEnviroScreen (PES) Final Score in the 80th percentile or greater. Applicants should follow these steps to identify the PES Final Score for their facility's location.

1. Click the link to access DEP's PennEnviroScreen mapping tool: <https://gis.dep.pa.gov/PennEnviroScreen/>
2. Enter the address of the facility in the search tool in the upper lefthand corner. Ex: State College, PA

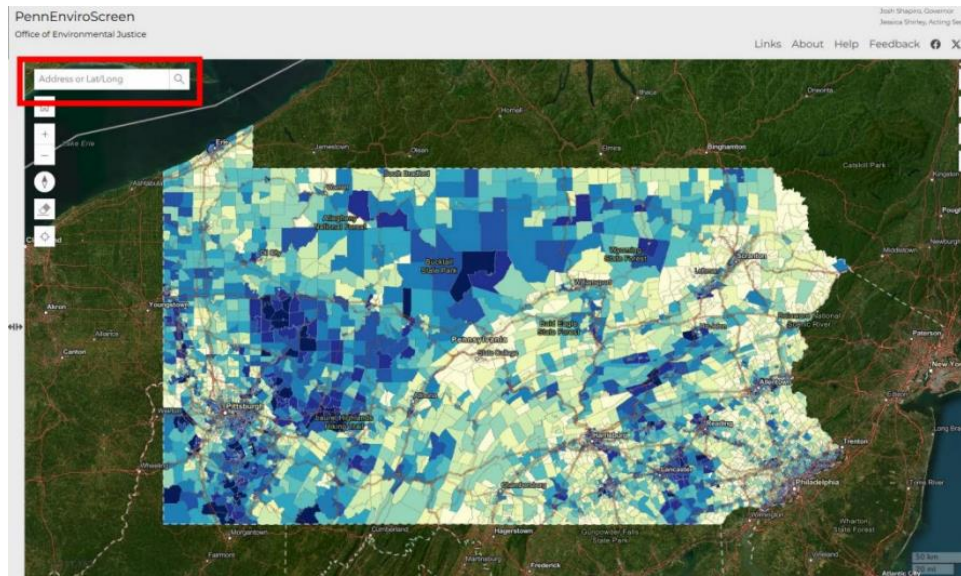


Figure 1: PA DEP's PennEnviroScreen Mapping Tool Address Look-up

3. The mapping tool will zoom to the location entered in the search tool.

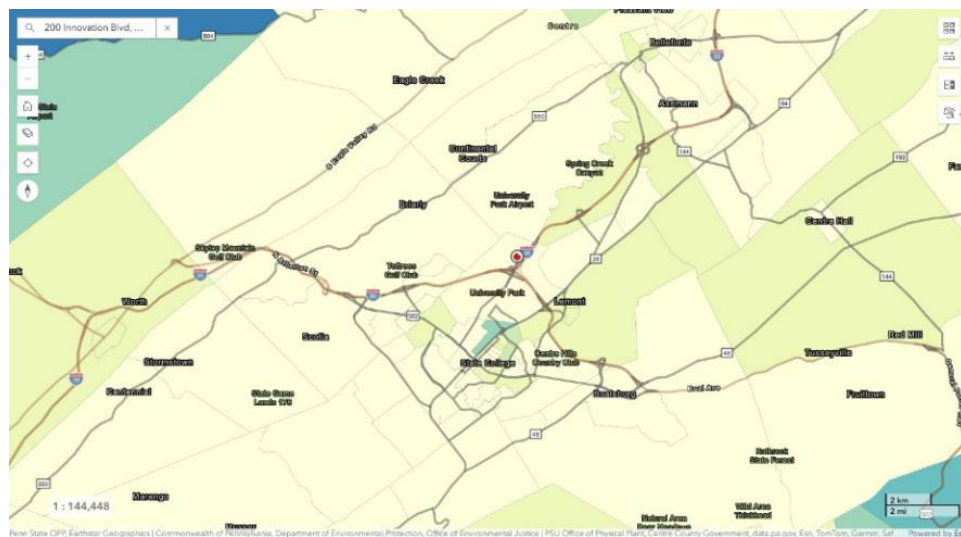


Figure 2: PA DEP's PennEnviroScreen Mapping Tool Street View

4. From this view, click on the location on the map. The sidebar on the left side of the screen will now show detailed information about the location for the PennEnviroScreen v1.1 (Current) view. In this example, the red dot indicates the location of the facility, and the site's information appears on the left side. Applications should screenshot this view (map and sidebar content) for inclusion in the Technical Assessment Report and application.

5. Under Block Group Info, look at the PES Final Score. For the RISE PA program, manufacturing sites with a PES Final Score in the 80th percentile or greater are considered to be located in a LIDAC area. In this example, this location in State College would not be considered to be in a LIDAC area. The RISE PA SAT application will request

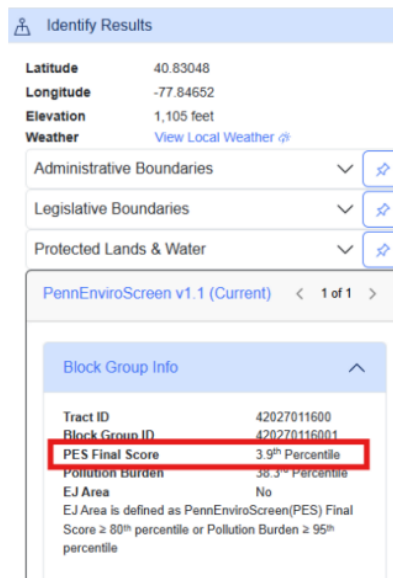


Figure 4: PA DEP's PennEnviroScreen Mapping Tool PES Final Score Percentile
