



# **EV Charging Rates Design**

## **Steps Towards Establishing a Policy Statement**



# Commission Order

In response to an earlier filed petition, the Commission issued an Order on November 10, 2022, which was entered as final on December 1, 2022. That Order required the following of Commission staff:

- Establishment of an EV charging rates design working group
- Filing of the working group's recommendations on this topic
- Drafting an Order addressing the disposition of the original petition



# Working Group Meetings

Commission staff convened two working group meetings. The working group consisted of 106 members with diverse interests:

## January 25, 2023

- At this meeting, Synapse Energy provided an overview of their study that was recently completed on this topic. Commission provided an overview of requirements, expectations and timeline to provide recommendations to the Commission.

## February 16, 2023

- At the request of the working group, Commission staff coordinated presentations by PECO and Duquesne Light Company staff on their respective EV pilots that the Commission had approved.





# Working Group Recommendations

- Over approximately a four-week period, Commission staff compiled recommendations from working group members.
- A draft report of those recommendations was provided to the working group on March 16. The final report was provided to the Commissioners on March 30. The document was filed at Docket P-2022-3030743 and posted to the Commission's [EV website](#).
- The final report contains 25 recommendations that the working group suggests should be incorporated into a policy statement supporting the establishment of an EV charging rates





# Next Steps

Consistent with the Order, Commission staff will prepare an order to address the original petition's request for a Policy Statement will separately draft a Policy Statement regarding electric vehicle rate design by June 1, 2023.
