DEP UPDATES

- EV Roadmap 2021 Update Booklet is available!
 - Access via Drive Electric PA Coalition webpage or the link above
- Light-duty ZEV proposed rulemaking
 - DEP announced its intention to join the light-duty ZEV program through regulation
 - DEP's Bureau of Air Quality will provide a detailed update during this meeting after member updates.
- Survey results from October 2021 meeting
 - Most DEPA members highly value the virtual option for DEPA meetings
 - Very few DEPA members would attend three in-person meetings per year if we returned to rotating locations
 - A slight majority of DEPA members would plan to attend one annual inperson meeting in Harrisburg most years



DEP UPDATES

- DEP's Level 2 Charging Equipment Rebate program has funded over 1,300 level 2 charging plugs

- DEP's DC Fast Charging and Hydrogen Fueling Grant program opened for applications on 10/29/2021 and will close on 1/31/2022!




I-80 ALTERNATIVE FUEL CORRIDOR



The I-80 Mid-America Alternative Fuel Corridor project:

- Six-state collaborative, including Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, New Jersey, Ohio, and Pennsylvania
- Fill gaps between DC Fast Chargers to be within 50 miles









UPDATES

- PA Legislative Updates
 - HB 948 (formerly 1392) Annual fee for electric vehicles
 - HB 1901 (formerly) Would enable EV direct sales
 - SB 435 (formerly 596) Would allow electric utilities to install charging equipment infrastructure
 - SB 153, HB 722 (formerly 845) Increases the maximum allowable weight of class 8 electric trucks by 2,000 pounds
 - Other
