THE STATE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION IS CURRENTLY ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR THE *BITUMINOUS UNDERGROUND MINE INSPECTOR* JOB TITLE, AS FUTURE VACANCIES ARE EXPECTED.

MINIMUM EXPERIENCE/TRAINING REQUIRED: Ten years of experience in underground bituminous coal mines, and graduation from high school or certification of equivalent training.

NECESSARY SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: (1) Possession of a valid Pennsylvania driver's license; and (2) Possession of a current and valid certificate as a bituminous mine foreman, assistant mine foreman or mine examiner issued by or acceptable to the Department of Environmental Protection.

CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT: Must be at least 30 years of age and a Pennsylvania resident.

DUTIES: Responsible for enforcing the state underground mining laws in an assigned area by performing regular technical inspections of underground coal mines in the bituminous coal fields.

LOCATION: Several vacancies are expected within the next year. Future vacancies would be located in the bituminous coal region in western Pennsylvania.

WORK SCHEDULE/SALARY: This position will work a 40-hour workweek and be on call 24 hours a day. The starting salary is \$65,868.
