Dear Mr. Rohrbaugh:

This letter acknowledges receipt of a letter dated August 21, 2009 from David C. Sharkins of Rosebud Mining Company requesting tentative approval to use the Rohmac Inc. Model 732 PC mantrip (ser No. 0006909001) at the Penfield Mine.

On August 6, 2009 the TAC and BMS traveled to the Rohmac shop to inspect the equipment. On August 17, 2009, BMS conducted a second inspection of the diesel powered mantrip at the Penfield Mine.

Based on the information provided and the TAC recommendation, the Department *temporarily approves* the Rohmac Inc. Model 732 PC mantrip with a Cummins A1700 37 HP diesel engine, an ENK particulate filter and a Clean Air Systems oxidation catalyst. The General Specification Sheet must be strictly complied with. The PA ventilation rate for this engine is 2,000 cfm.

The Bureau of Mine Safety (BMS) will assign BOTE-D and BOTE-DEES numbers upon final approval.

The next scheduled meeting of the Diesel Technical Advisory Committee is scheduled for October 14, 2009, upon which time a formal recommendation will be provided. Should you have any questions regarding the process, contact my office at the above phone number.
