The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the supplemental Horizontal Directional Drill (HDD) analysis that Sunoco Pipeline, L.P. (SPLP) submitted for the Whitehouse Ln. 16-inch HDD Location (S3-0011-16) and permitted under Permit E22-617. The SPLP HDD re-evaluation was posted on the DEP Pipeline Portal on February 18, 2019. SPLP submitted additional information for this HDD re-evaluation on May 23, 2019. The supplemental information is adequate with the understanding that you will be proceeding as set forth in your re-evaluation.

The DEP's review of the geologic aspects of this HDD re-evaluation were completed by a Licensed Professional Geologist.

You may proceed with the permitted HDD activity in the manner proposed in your re-evaluation and in accordance with all applicable permit terms and conditions, including the HDD IR and Water Supply PPC plans.
