The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the supplemental HDD re-evaluation response, which was posted to the DEP Mariner East II pipeline portal webpage on October 11, 2018 for the Susquehanna River 16" HDD location (S2-0280).


Based on the Department's review of the HDD re-evaluation response, DEP notes the following:

In response to Item #1 identified in Sunoco Pipeline, L.P.'s (SPLP) HDD re-evaluation response, SPLP states that Section 6.2 of the DEP approved Water Supply Assessment, Preparedness, Prevention, and Contingency Plan (Water Supply Plan) will be implemented during construction of the HDD entry pit. Section 6.2 of the Water Supply Plan applies to all aspects of the pipeline construction. Section 6.2 is required to be implemented if there is any evidence of hazardous materials being encountered while HDD is being conducted. Under the terms and conditions of the permits and approved plans, including Section 6.2 of the Water Supply Plan, HDD activities must be suspended if it is determined that any hazardous materials encountered pose a threat to health, safety, or the environment.

The supplemental information is adequate. You may proceed with the permitted HDD activity in the manner proposed in your re-evaluation, the re-evaluation response letter, and in accordance with all applicable permit terms and conditions and plans approved thereunder.
