Meeting was called to order at 10:02 am.

Approval of June 8, 2022 Meeting Minutes

Mr. Kyle provided a minor edit, which others agreed with, then motioned to approve the June 8, 2022 meeting minutes with the suggested edit incorporated. Chairperson Roland seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Approval of New and Upgrade Applications

Ms. Chambers presented the following new and upgraded licenses for Board consideration:

Reciprocity Requests

Water

<u>Unity Oviasogie</u> – Holds an Arizona Grade 2 Water Distribution license and an Arizona Grade 3 Water Treatment license that were both issued in October 2013 and expire on October 31, 2022. His application documents 2 years, 5 months' experience working at Wilkinsburg-Penn Joint Water Authority Filter Plant, which is a Class A facility using subclasses 1,4,8,10,11.

An operator is required to have a minimum of 2 years of experience in order to obtain a Pennsylvania Class C license. Therefore, the Department's determination is that Mr. Oviasogie has documented the adequate experience relative to a WC-1.

Regarding the comparison of examination questions, the applicant passed water exams developed by ABC and administered in the State of Arizona.

The Department's recommendation: The Board should please review the examination information provided and vote on whether Mr. Oviasogie has documented that he has passed comparable examinations in the State of Arizona.

Chairperson Roland motioned to approve Mr. Oviasogie's WC-1 license. Mr. Kyle seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
