BWM TGD Update Goals Recap

- Changes to 5 TGDs were presented to SWAC September 16, 2022
- Only minor revisions anticipated (i.e., grammar fixes, updates, etc.)
- Today's purpose is to discuss 4 additional TGDs anticipated for publication in Q1 2023

- Document Number 250-4000-004
- Establishes a formalized methodology by which the BWM will implement a compliance and enforcement program throughout the Commonwealth.

Performing Municipal & Residual Waste Facility Inspections

- Document Number: 254-3120-001
- Establishes a formalized procedure for DEP staff to conduct municipal and residual waste facility inspections across the six DEP regions.
- Originally published September 17, 2005
- Formatting and other changes for consistency with similar TGDs and to reflect current operations

▶ PPC Plans for Waste Oil Generators & Burners

- Document Number 254-5900-001
- Provides a simple PPC alternative for waste oil generators/burners to promptly respond to spills/emergencies while protecting Commonwealth waterways/environment.
- Originally published October 31, 2002
- Formatting and other changes for clarity and consistency with current regulations
