

Update on USGS Budget Tool

- USGS is continuing to finalize Q₇₋₁₀ statistics by end of March
- Completed definition of pour points and equations for the Delaware River Basin
- Beginning process of pour point definition and equations for Susquehanna Basin
- The development of StreamStats National program of gage data nearly complete for state

- Working Pilot of the budget tool for the Lehigh River later this summer
- "Hand computations" complete for the Neshaminy Creek
- Watershed information was provided for the Laurel Hill (western PA) and Cocalico Creek (Lancaster County) watersheds
