

# Corrections to By-Laws:

## Article XI: Amendment of By-Laws

The By-Laws may be amended at any meeting of the Statewide Committee by ~~two-thirds~~ majority vote of the full voting Statewide Committee membership (~~16 voting members~~) provided that written notice of such change has been sent via email with a read receipt or email acknowledgement from each member at least two weeks prior to the meeting.

## Article VI: Voting

A. Members shall be entitled to one (1) vote, in person or via teleconference or videoconference when applicable, on all matters that come before the Statewide Committee. The Chair and Vice-Chair shall be allowed to vote on all matters before the Statewide Committee.

B. A majority of the membership of the Statewide Committee shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of Statewide Committee business. Action may only be taken on a matter before the Statewide Committee by a majority vote (~~16 voting members~~) of the full voting membership of the Committee.
