The minutes of the July 13, 2011 meeting were approved on motion.

New Business:

DEP Reorganization

Marcus Kohl (mkohl@.pa.gov) provided an overview of the Department's reorganization, explaining the changes that will be taking place and answered questions about the Office of Water Management's restructuring.

Discuss SPGP-4

Ken Murin (kmurin@pa.gov) and Barry Newman (banewman@pa.gov), Bureau of Watershed Management, discussed and summarized the changes to PAG-13 which was recently published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. Ken reviewed the high points of the changes, clarifications and municipal requirements.

Chapter 93, Water Quality Standards Triennial Review (25 Pa. Code, Chapter 93) -

Rod Kime (rkime@pa.gov), Bureau of Water Standards and Facility Regulation, held an additional discussion with WRAC on the proposed Triennial Review of Chapter 93. Rod discussed the list of parameters not in the review and to be addressed in possible separate rulemakings (Ammonia, Temperature, Flouride & Manganese, Phenolic for aquatic life criteria, Aluminum, Bromide, and Radium, Uranium, Gross alpha and beta, and other radionuclides); two parameters added to the triennial rulemaking (Sulfate, Chloride); parameters still in the triennial; metals criteria; and improvements to the notification process.

It is expected that a vote will be requested at the January meeting as the rulemaking must go to the EQB in March. A possibility of an additional WRAC meeting in December was also discussed. The group requested that this meeting allow for remote attendance and participation.

Draft Revisions to BWM-GP-8 Temporary Road Crossings – Sid Freyermuth addressed WRAC regarding changes to the GP-8 Temporary Road Crossings permit.

<u>General Discussion</u> WRAC members asked questions on various issues and suggested topics for upcoming meetings, including Act 167; what DEP sees for WRAC after Chapter 93; updates on Chapters 95 and 96; and the water impact of Chapter 78.

Public Comment

One guest in attendance asked a clarifying question on GP 8 (aerial crossings).

The meeting was adjourned at 11:40 a.m.
