Approval of Minutes

The minutes of the October 12, 2011 meeting were approved on motion.

Chapter 93, Water Quality Standards Triennial Review (25 Pa. Code, Chapter 93) -

Rod Kime (rkime@pa.gov), Rod McAllister (romcallist@pa.gov), Bonita Moore (bmoore@pa.gov) and Heidi Biggs (hbiggs@pa.gov), Bureau of Water Standards and Facility Regulation, held their fifth discussion with WRAC on the proposed Triennial Review of Chapter 93. DEP staff highlighted the changes to the Annex and reviewed their anticipated timeline.

WRAC will be requested to vote on the Triennial at the January 11, 2012, meeting. It is projected that DEP will present the proposed rulemaking before the EQB at the March 2012 meeting and return before WRAC in the summer/fall of 2012. The final rulemaking is scheduled to be published April 13, 2013, with a May 15, 2013 due date to EPA.

Staff reviewed the Annex with WRAC members and questions were received on chloride, sulfates, dissolved oxygen, temperature, benzene, molybdenum, and dioxane. WRAC members expressed concern over not seeing rationale documents prior to the January 11 meeting where a vote will be requested. DEP will circulate links to their sources for the scientific background for their rationale to WRAC members.
