Re: Final-omitted rulemaking for the repeal of portable fuel containers regulation

Dear Secretary Krancer:

On June 23, 2011, and August 4, 2011, the Air Quality Technical Advisory Committee (Committee) discussed the final-omitted rulemaking to repeal requirements in 25 *Pa. Code* Chapter 130 (relating to standards for products), Subchapter A (relating to portable fuel containers), promulgated at 32 *Pa.B.* 4819 (October 4, 2002).

The Commonwealth-specific regulation is no longer necessary since a more stringent Federal regulation, applicable Nationwide, was promulgated at 72 FR 8428 (February 26, 2007) that applies to all portable fuel, diesel, and kerosene containers and spouts manufactured or imported on and after January 1, 2009. The Federal requirements are codified at 40 CFR §§ 59.600-59.699, regarding control of evaporative emissions from new and in-use portable fuel containers.

The Committee voted 12-2-2 to concur with the Department's recommendation to present the final-omitted rulemaking to the Environmental Quality Board for consideration.
