Purpose of Rulemaking

Correcting Errors in Existing Regulations:

- Correct Aldrin medium-specific concentration (MSC) transcription error
- Correct cadmium toxicity value transcription error and associated MSC
- Correct beryllium toxicity value transcription error and associated MSC



Purpose of Rulemaking

- Protective of human health.
- Predictability of cleanups.



Affected Parties

- Owners, operators and purchasers of properties and facilities who volunteer or are required to perform remediation of contaminated sites.
- Changes not expected to add costs to remediation.



Final-Omitted Rulemaking Process

- Final-omitted process chosen for this rulemaking.
- Public comment is both unnecessary and contrary to the public interest for these corrections.



Advisory Group Review

The proposed corrections have been reviewed and endorsed by the Cleanup Standards Scientific Advisory Board.



Recommendation

DEP recommends the Board adopt this final-omitted rulemaking.
