Background

- Chapter 102: Erosion and Sediment (E&S) Control and Post-Construction Stormwater Management (PCSM) for earth disturbance activities
- 25 Pa. Code § 102.6(b)(2) requires DEP to evaluate the adequacy of fees and report to Environmental Quality Board (EQB) every three years
- County Conservation Districts (CCDs) are delegated to administer portions of the Chapter 102 program
- A fee rulemaking finalized in 2021 included new annual fee for Chapter 102 Individual NPDES Permits



Chapter 102 Permit Fees

- 25 Pa. Code § 102.6(b)(1): Chapter 102 Permit Fees
- 25 Pa. Code § 92a.62: Chapter 102 Individual NPDES Permit Annual Fee

Fee Type	Permit Type	Fee
Base Administrative Filing Fee	General Permits (NPDES PAG-01 and PAG-02 and ESCGP)	\$500
Base Administrative Filing Fee	Individual Permits (NPDES and E&S)	\$1,500
Disturbed Acreage Fee	All Permits	\$100 x each disturbed acre
Annual Fee	Individual NPDES Permits	\$500

Chapter 102 Fees

Fees collected by DEP:

- Base Administrative Filing Fee – DEP only collects if performing a completeness review of application/NOI
- Disturbed Acreage Fee
- Annual Fee

Fees collected by CCDs:

- Base Administrative Filing Fee
- CCD Service Fees (including PCSM Fee)



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DEP Program Costs and Fees Collected

- Fiscal Years (FY) 2021-2022, 2022-2023, and 2023-2024
- Program Costs = DEP Staff Costs (Central and Regional Offices), including Overhead, and Training and Research Costs
- Fees Collected = Base Administrative Filing Fees, Disturbed Acreage Fees, and Annual Fees

DEP Program Costs and Fees Collected

To close the gap between fees collected and program expenses, DEP uses:

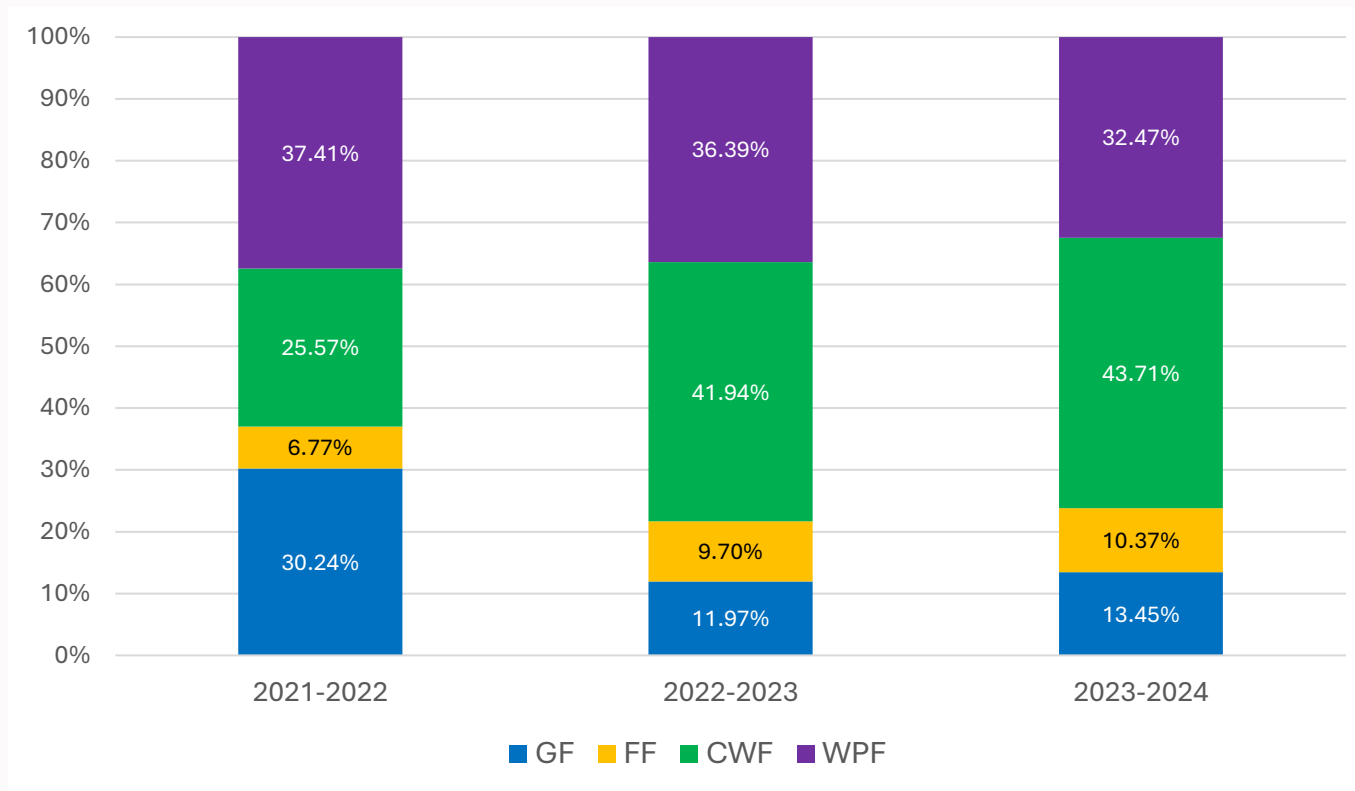
- General Fund (GF)
- Clean Water Fund (CWF)
- Well Plugging Fund (WPF)
 - DEP Oil and Gas staff costs for Chapter 102 activities
 - Beginning FY 2024-2025, supplemented with GF to offset declining WPF balance
- Federal Funds (FF)

Costs and fees collected associated with DEP's implementation of the Chapter 102 program illustrating the revenue to cost ratio.

	FY 2021-2022	FY 2022-2023	FY 2023-2024
Program Costs	\$7,669,640	\$7,595,761	\$8,509,837
Fees Collected	\$3,972,480	\$4,324,012	\$3,918,888
Difference	(\$3,697,160)	(\$3,271,750)	(\$4,590,949)
Ratio	52%	57%	46%



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CCD Program Costs and Fees Collected

- Fiscal Years (FY) 2021-2022, 2022-2023, and 2023-2024
- Program Costs = Total Program Costs reported by CCDs, plus Overhead
- Fees Collected = Base Administrative Filing Fee and Service Fees

Difference	(\$6,605,681)	(\$5,724,861)	(\$5,623,046)
Ratio	77%	82%	83%

Projections

- Fiscal Years (FY) 2024-2025 through 2026-2027
- Program Costs estimated to increase by 4%
- Fees Collected estimated to increase by 2.2%, 2.6% and 2.6% for each FY, respectively

Recommendation

DEP plans to evaluate the potential for increasing Chapter 102 permit fees. Depending on this evaluation, DEP may draft a proposed rulemaking to address the disparity between program costs and sustainable funding sources including fee revenues.
