A proposed plan approval was submitted to KDI Wyalusing Power, LLC (KDI) for the for the construction and operation the Wyalusing Energy Center (WEC) located in Wyalusing Township, Bradford County on June 30, 2025. Please see the application review memo in the facility's FAC/FAC OP file for the technical information pertaining to this application. The public notice for the Department's intent to issue the proposed plan approval was published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin on July 12, 2025. During the comment period that followed the Pennsylvania Bulletin publication over 100 people submitted comments on the proposed plan approval to construct and operate the Wyalusing Energy Center (WEC).

The initial application review memo dated June 30, 2025, erroneously stated that the Act 14 notices sent to the township and county were received by them in 2018. The Act 14 notices were included in the application as Appendix D and were received by the township and county on December 14, 2024.

Attached to this memo is the comment response document addressing all comments provided during the public comment period. The Department's responses contained in the document adequately address all comments received on the proposed plan approval.

Based on my review of the application, supplemental material, the comments received, as well as the above facts, I recommend that plan approval be issued to KDI for the construction and operation the Wyalusing Energy Center (WEC) located in Wyalusing Township, Bradford County. All applicable Federal and State regulations including the Best Available Technology (BAT) requirements have been included in this Plan Approval. In addition, appropriate monitoring, recordkeeping, and reporting conditions regarding compliance with the requirements have been included in the plan approval.
