Dear Mr. Hlavinka:

As you are already aware, the Department of Environmental Protection (“Department”) and Coterra Energy Inc. (“Coterra”) entered into a Consent Order and Agreement on November 29, 2022 (“COA”). In accordance with Paragraph 3.e.i. of the COA, Coterra was required to submit a written Funding Notice to the Department for review and approval, upon determination that any owner of a Subject Water Supply refused Interim Treatment as required by Paragraph 3.c. of the COA. On May 1, 2023, via electronic mail, the Department received Coterra’s Funding Notice. In the Funding Notice, Coterra identified six property owners of Subject Water Supplies who refused Interim Treatment, and one property owner who failed to provide an affirmative response. Based on an analysis of the treatment needs of each of those seven Subject Water Supplies, Coterra proposes to place \$450,000 into a Mitigation Fund as required by Paragraph 3.e.ii. of the COA, for possible future installation of Interim Treatment on the identified Subject Water Supplies as required by Paragraph 3.e.iv.

The Department has reviewed the Funding Notice pursuant to Paragraph 5 of the COA and hereby approves the Funding Notice submitted on May 1, 2023. The approved Funding Notice is now a part of the COA for all purposes and is enforceable as such.
