

## **PUBLIC NOTICE—PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) will hold a virtual public hearing on Tuesday, July 2, 2024, beginning at 6:00 PM.

The purpose of this hearing is to accept and record testimony concerning the Pennsylvania General Energy Co., LLC (PGE) Phase IV Pipeline project application to construct 19,925 linear feet of 12” natural gas pipeline and 19,887 linear feet of two flexsteel waterlines in Cummings & McHenry Townships, Lycoming County.

Individuals who wish to present testimony at the virtual hearing and for inclusion in the administrative record must contact Megan Lehman, Regional Communications Manager, by email at [meglehman@pa.gov](mailto:meglehman@pa.gov) or by phone at 570-327-3659 before noon on Monday, July 1, 2024, to reserve a time to present testimony. A link for those testifying to access the virtual hearing will be provided upon registration. Verbal testimony is limited to 3 minutes for each witness. Video demonstrations and screen sharing by witnesses will not be permitted. DEP asks that organizations designate one speaker per group. Time may not be shared or relinquished to others.

Those wishing only to listen and not testify may join the hearing via phone or internet connection. Persons unable to attend the public hearing can submit a written statement to the DEP by close of business on Monday, July 22, 2024. All comments, whether delivered orally during the virtual hearing or submitted in writing, carry equal weight and consideration with DEP.
