Pete would it be possible to have a teleconference in a week or two to discuss the proposed mitigation for this proposal prior to submittal. As the project is to be located in high quality watershed, it maybe better to complete the stream mitigation on site to offset the impacts. Since this is high quality, we want to ensure this stream watershed is protected and enhanced as much as possible. I would also like to have DEP at this meeting so that we are all on the same page. I would also like to discuss your stream assessment determination as far as ratio's, as I assume since it is in a high quality watershed, the ratio is more than 1:1.

I would also like to discuss the avoidance and minimization measures to ensure that this project has avoided and minimized impacts to the maximum extent possible. That includes a discussion on alternate alignments, the use of bridges in lieu of culverts...

We are booked up this week and next, but is it possible to have a discussion March 9th or the 12th.
