On June 10, 2026, the Department received an application for plan approval for the construction of two new identical natural gas-fired combined cycle turbine trains, at the site of the existing Montour Steam Electric Station, located in Derry Township, Montour County. The Department has determined that the application package contains sufficient detail to enable DEP to conduct the technical review, and has been accepted for that purpose. This application also contains sufficient detail that satisfies the administrative completeness requirements for New Source Review pursuant to 25 Pa. Code Section 127.203a and Prevention of Significant Deterioration pursuant to 40 CFR 52.21.

This is not a final action by the Department on this application. The completeness review is the first in a series of reviews conducted by DEP. The application will now move to the technical review stage of the permit review process.
