MODIFICATION TO SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND/OR PROCESSING PERMIT

Under the provisions of Act 97, the Solid Waste Management Act of July 7, 1980, Solid Waste Permit
Number 101247 issued on (date original permit was issued) May 23, 1990 to

is hereby modified as follows:

1. This minor permit modification is being issued pursuant to the Pennsylvania Solid Waste Management Act of July 7, 1980, and the Municipal Waste Management Regulations effective September 14, 2002.
2. This minor permit modification is based on the information in the application package received by the Department on April 29, 2024. The application included the following documents:
 1. Introduction and Checklist
 2. General Information Form
 3. Form A – Application for Municipal or Residual Waste Permit
 4. Form B – Professional Certification
 5. Form B1 – Application for Certification
 6. Form HW-C – Compliance History
 7. Form I – Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control
 8. Form 25 – Leachate Management – Phase II Application
 9. Form 28 – Closure-Post Closure Land Use Plan
 10. Attachments
 - i. Attachment A – Figures
 - ii. Attachment B – Geotechnical Investigation Information
 - iii. Attachment C – Tank Information
 - iv. Attachment D – Air Treatment System Information
 - v. Attachment E – Jet Mix Aeration System Information
3. The following documents were received on November 14 and December 10, 2024:
 - i. Bonding Worksheets
4. This permit modification authorizes Keystone Sanitary Landfill to install two, 2.5-MG aboveground storage tanks for the storage of leachate prior to treatment.
5. Keystone Sanitary Landfill shall only utilize one Lagoon for leachate storage at any given time. Approval must be obtained from the Department prior to utilizing the Lagoon not in use.
6. Following precipitation, within 48-hours the Lagoon not in use shall have any water removed. During precipitation lasting greater than 48-hours, the Lagoon not in use shall be dewatered into the operating lagoon (unless otherwise approved by the Department) once the precipitation has ceased or if the volume of water in the Lagoon not in use exceeds 25% of the volume of that Lagoon.

7. The volume to be used for calculating 25% of leachate storage capacity (for flow equalization per 25 PA C.S. 273.275) shall include both aboveground storage tanks, and one lagoon. The volume to be used for flow equalization shall be submitted to the Department for approval prior to putting the tanks into use.

This modification shall be attached to the existing Solid Waste Permit described above and shall become a part thereof effective on (date) December 19, 2024.
