NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Nesselbeck:

On August 14, 2019, the Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") conducted an inspection at Erie Coke Corporation. The following violations were observed:

- (a) During coke pushing of oven 14, visible fugitive air contaminants of greater than 20% opacity were observed escaping from the Coke Side Shed in violation of 25 Pa. Code § 129.15(c), and Expired Title V Operating Permit, Section D, Source 802, Condition #001(c).
- (b) In accordance with the Expired Title V Operating Permit, Section D, Source 808, all coke loading into trucks shall be controlled by a Foam Generator Dust Supressor as necessary, to achieve compliance with 25 Pa. Code § 123.1. Erie Coke Corporation loaded coke into trucks without the possible use of the Foam Generator Dust Supressor, in violation of the Expired Title V Operating Permit, Section D, Source 808, Condtion #003(b), and 25 Pa. Code § 127.444.

Any violation of the Air Pollution Control Act subjects a person to enforcement actions, including civil and criminal penalties. Each day the violation continues constitutes a separate offense.

This Notice of Violation is neither an order nor any other final action of the Department. It neither imposes nor waives any enforcement action available to the Department under any of its statutes. If the Department determines that an enforcement action is appropriate, you will be notified of the action.
