- 1. <u>Application Form</u> Each page of the application must be completed in entirety. Incomplete portions include those sections of the application regarding source and control device information.
- 2. <u>Supporting Emissions Documentation</u> Documentation in support of emission estimates was not included. Acceptable documentation may include manufacturer guarantees and emissions data measured on an identical unit.
- 3. <u>Specifications</u> Source and control device specifications and design documentation were not included.
- 4. <u>Emission Calculations</u> Emission calculations were not included. Only summaries of unknown emissions data were provided.
