Re: Transfer of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs) owned by Anew Environmental, LLC (“Anew”) to Homer City Generation, LP (“HCG”)

Dear Mr. Lack,

This letter is in reference to your letter received on May 13, 2025, requesting the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to transfer a total of 24.18 tons per year (tpy) of VOC ERCs from Anew to HCG. These VOC ERCs are created from the shutdown of sources at the Bemis Hazleton facility located in Hazle Township, Luzerne County.
