Re: Transfer of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs) owned by Ball Corporation (“Ball”) to Homer City Generation, LP (“HCG”)

Dear Mr. Levesque,

This letter is in reference to your letter received on July 17, 2025, requesting the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to transfer a total of 81 tons per year (tpy) of VOC ERCs from Ball to HCG. These VOC ERCs are created from the shutdown of sources at Mack Trucks Macungie Facility located in Lower Macungie Township, Lehigh County.

The DEP is approving your request to transfer a total of 81 tpy of VOC ERCs from Ball to HCG on September 17, 2025, and the ERC Registry system revised accordingly. The VOC ERCs are now available for use at HCG in accordance with the requirements of 25 Pa. Code Chapter 127 (relating to construction, modification, reactivation and operation of sources).

Under 25 Pa. Code § 127.206(f), 9.796 tpy of VOC ERCs generated from the shutdown of Source 106 at Mack Trucks Macungie Facility located in Lehigh County will expire on December 04, 2026, 71.196 tpy of VOC from Source IDs 103, 104, 118A, and 119A will expire on December 08, 2026, and 0.008 tpy of VOC from Source ID 003 will expire August 01, 2027 if the credits are not used in a plan approval or operating permit prior to the expiration dates.
