Re: Transfer of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs) from INDSPEC Chemical Corporation to Homer City Generation, LP

Dear Mr. Levesque,

This letter is in reference to your letter received on March 17, 2025, requesting the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) to transfer a total of 199.54 tons per year (tpy) of VOC ERCs from INDSPEC Chemical Corporation (INDSPEC) to Homer City Generation, LP (HCG). These VOC are created from the shutdown of sources at INDSPEC Petrolia Plant facility located in Petrolia Borough, Butler County.

The DEP is approving your request to transfer a total of 199.54 tpy of VOC ERCs from INDSPEC on June 4, 2025, and the ERC Registry system revised accordingly. The VOC ERCs are now available for use at HCG in accordance with the requirements of 25 Pa. Code Chapter 127 (relating to construction, modification, reactivation and operation of sources).

Under 25 Pa. Code § 127.206(f), the 68.6 tpy of VOC ERCs generated from the shutdown of sources at INDSPEC Petrolia Plant facility located in Petrolia, Pennsylvania will expire on September 11, 2027, if the credits are not used in a plan approval or operating permit prior to the expiration date.
