Shawn Simmers:

Enclosed is your copy of your State Water Obstruction and Encroachment Permit (WOEP). Please review this permit so that you are aware of the extent of authorization and the conditions that apply to that authorization. The Department will provide you with an acknowledgment letter upon receipt of the fully-signed Acknowledgment of Appraisal of Permit Conditions.

The WOEP is not effective until a copy of the Acknowledgment of Appraisal of Permit Conditions, signed by you, is received by the Department. Any work conducted prior to the Department's receipt of the signed Acknowledgment of Appraisal of Permit Conditions is a violation of the Dam Safety and Encroachments Act and the Clean Streams Law, and you may be subject to fines and penalties pursuant to those Acts.

Prior to the commencement of construction, the enclosed Acknowledgment of Appraisal of Permit Conditions must be completed and signed by you and an individual responsible for the supervision or conduct of the construction work acknowledging and accepting the general and special conditions contained in the permit. Unless the signed Acknowledgment of Appraisal of Permit Conditions is submitted to this office, the permit is void.

A copy of both the Permit and the signed Acknowledgment of Appraisal of Permit Conditions must be available at the work site for inspection upon request by any officer or agent of the Department or any other federal, state, county and municipal agency.

The Completion Report form must be signed by you and the supervising engineer indicating that the work has been completed as approved. The Completion Report must be submitted to this office within 30 days of the completion of the approved project.

Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal the action to the Environmental Hearing Board (Board), pursuant to Section 4 of the Environmental Hearing Board Act, 35 P.S. § 7514, and the Administrative Agency Law, 2 Pa.C.S. Chapter 5A. The Board's address is:

Appeals must be filed with the Board within 30 days of receipt of notice of this action unless the appropriate statute provides a different time. This paragraph does not, in and of itself, create any right of appeal beyond that permitted by applicable statutes and decisional law.


