<u>January 10, 2023 Local Municipal Involvement Process Meeting Summary</u> Chambersburg Waste Paper Inc. Municipal Waste Transfer Station

On January 10, 2023, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Southcentral Region Waste Management Program met with Chambersburg Waste Paper (CWP) Inc., Martin & Martin Inc., Palmer Construction Company Inc., and delegates for Representative Rob Kauffman and Senator Doug Mastriano to discuss an application submitted by Chambersburg Waste Paper Inc. The facility is proposing to receive up to 300 tons of municipal solid waste, construction demolition waste, and approved residual waster per day. Recyclable material will be removed from the waste and the waste will then be reloaded into a transfer vehicle for transport to a permitted waste disposal site.

DEP presented a brief overview of the local municipal involvement process, as well as an overview of the application review and environmental assessment process. Martin & Martin then presented an overview of the permit application.

An open discussion, question-and-answer session followed Martin & Martin's presentation. DEP asked where the Guilford Township boundary line was on the property, as there was some discrepancy with online maps. Martin and Martin Inc. responded that they will provide clarification as to the location of the Guilford Township boundary line.

DEP asked if there were any issues with traffic and tractor trailers on the haul route and whether PennDOT has been contacted. Martin and Martin will provide clarification as part of the permit review process.

Chambersburg Waste Paper Inc. is going to transfer waste from multiple smaller load vehicles to larger capacity trucks for proper transportation to the landfill. This will reduce the overall number of trucks from the facility to dispose of waste. CWP will use RT 11 for access to the transfer station. Recycling will then occur for what's easily distinguishable. Berms and screening are already in place and the stormwater management facility is already constructed. The land development plan has already been approved.

CWP currently has an area for construction/demolition to recycle clean materials operating under a DEP Solid Waste Management General Permit. Stationary mount radiation monitors will be mounted at weigh scales or hand held devices will be used.

The application will be documented as received as of the date of the this LMIP meeting, 1/10/2023. The application will be published in the PA Bulletin at a later date.
