We have completed our review of the above-referenced plan, as prepared by Tetra Tech, and the accompanying documentation that was received by the Borough on November 12, 2015. The proposed pipeline project appears to extend approximately 750-feet into the southeastern corner of Highspire Borough and there do not appear to be any surface improvements, such as a permanent access or pump station, proposed within the Borough. We have found that the proposed plan is generally consistent with the Highspire Borough Stormwater Management Ordinance and Floodplain Management Program.
