Outfall 001 is located at 39° 46' 9.23" N, 77° 26' 37.99" W on the right-hand side of Toms Creek along Gum Springs Road. Outfall 002 is located at 39° 46' 04.80" N, 77° 26' 09.11" W on the left-hand side of Unnamed Tributary to Toms Creek along Iron Springs Road.
